House Vote #1: Endangered Species Act Flood Waivers. An attempt by Rep. Sherwood Boehlert (R-NY) to water down the ESA flood waivers bill with a substitute amendment to provide project exemption limitations to waivers of the Endangered Species Act consultation regulations for repair or replacement of flood control projects in counties declared federal disaster areas through 1998 and waive the requirements for repairs to any project that presents a substantial threat to human lives and property. The amendment passed 227-196 on May 7, 1997. A "yea" was a vote in support of the President's position. The private property position was a no. (This vote was counted twice because this vote was considered precedent setting for votes on other environmental issues in the 105th Congress. Members were told ahead of time that if this bill failed to pass, other environmental legislation would be postponed or ignored).

House Vote #2: Biosphere and World Heritage -- Interior Appropriations. The amendment by Rep. Tom Coburn (R-OK) was to prohibit the use of Interior Department funds in the bill for the US Man and Biosphere Program or the World Heritage Program administered by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization. It passed 222-203 on July 15, 1997. (This is a different vote on a different appropriations bill than Vote #2). The private property position was yes.

House Vote #3: Private Propertt Rights - Local Land Use Decision Appeals. Rep. Sherwood Boehlert's (R-NY) substitute amendment to eliminate the bill's provisions that allow a private property owner to appeal local land use decisions in the federal courts, while retaining provisions that allow expedited federal court consideration of land use disputes involving the federal government. Rejected 178-242 on Oct. 22, 1997. The private property position was no.

HOUSE VOTE #4: Government Performance and Results - Passage. Final passage of the bill to require federal agencies to revise and resubmit to Congress, by the end of fiscal 1998, their "strategic plans" to outline their mission, general goals and objectives, and describe how those goals and objectives will be achieved. The bill also requires agency inspectors general to annually audit agency performance reports and submit the results to Congress. Passed 242-168 on March 12, 1998. The property rights position was yes.

HOUSE VOTE #5: Private Property Rights – US District Courts. Rep. Melvin Watt(D-NC) offered an amendment to grant the US District Courts jurisdiction to determine all claims arising out of disputes over government seizure of private property. The Watt amendment was rejected 206-206 on. March 12, 1998. The property rights position was no.

HOUSE VOTE #6: Private Property Rights - Passage. Passage of the bill to give landowners greater leeway in suing the federal government for disputes over government seizure of private property, by allowing such suits to be heard either in the US District Court or the US Court of Federal Claims. Passed 230-180 on March 12, 1998. A "nay" was a vote in support of the president's position. The property rights position was yes.

HOUSE VOTE #7: Forest Recovery - Road Construction. Rep. Sherwood Boehlert (R-NY) offered an amendment to Rep. Bob Smith (R-OR) amendment that would prohibit the building of roads in roadless areas not already allowed under current law. The Boehlert amendment was adopted 200-187 on March 27, 1998. (Subsequently, the Smith amendment, as amended, was rejected by voice vote). The property rights position was no.

HOUSE VOTE #8: Fiscal 1999 Interior Appropriations -- Columbia River Watershed Management. Rep. Jim McDermott (D-WA) offered an amendment to strike the bill's provisions that place certain limitations on the use of funds for implementation of the proposed regional strategy to manage the Columbia River watershed. The McDermott amendment was rejected 202-221 on July 23, 1998. A "yea" was a vote in support of the president's position. The property rights position was no.

HOUSE VOTE #9: Fiscal 1999 Interior Appropriations - Chugach National Forest Road Construction. Rep. Maurice Hinchey (D-NY) offered an amendment to strike the bill's provisions providing for a road construction easement in the Chugach National Forest in Alaska. The Hinchey amendment was rejected 176-249 on July 23, 1998. The property rights position was no.

HOUSE VOTE #10: Fiscal 1999 Interior Appropriations - Tongass National Forest Road Construction Prohibition. Rep. George Miller (D-CA) offered an amendment to prohibit the use of funds in the bill for new road construction in the Tongass National Forest in Alaska. The Miller amendment was rejected 186-237 on July 23, 1998. The property rights position was no.

HOUSE VOTE #11: Guadalupe-Hidalgo Treaty Land Claims - Passage. Passage of the bill to establish a presidential commission to make recommendations to resolve land claims in New Mexico by descendants of Mexican citizens when the treaty ending the Mexican-American War was signed in 1848. Passed 223-187 on Sept. 10, 1998. Property rights position was yes.

HOUSE VOTE #12: Co-sponsorship of HR 1995 – Point Reyes National Seashore Farmland Protection Act of 1997. This is not a vote of record, the House has not voted on HR 1995 introduced by Rep. Lynn Woolsey (D-CA) on June 19, 1997. This bill would place 38,000 acres of important farmland under threat of condemnation and converting it to Federal ownership. This will ultimately eliminate over 90 historically significant farm families. Over 90% of these families oppose this legislation. Rep. Woolsey has collected 228 co-sponsors to this bill. Property rights position is no.
